Value

As with many purchasing decisions you may choose to spend less upfront but it may cost more over time. Weber grills “might” cost a little more upfront, but their grills will last twice as long as their competitors. Genesis and Summit grills will easily last 20 years. Their burners are warranted for 10 years and the grill body for 25 years. See if you can find a warranty like that among their competitors.

Performance

The Weber Stephen Product Company was founded in 1893 and built their first BBQ grill in 1952. Since that time they have been doing it so well, the name Weber has become synonymous with BBQ. While their Charcoal Kettle grills are the most popular grill in the USA, their gas grill cooking system is unique in the industry and has the following advantages:

- Stainless burners with a 10 year warranty
- Flavor Bars that completely cover the burners which eliminates clogged holes preventing hot and cold spots
- Grease cannot collect above the burners which eliminates "flare-ups"
- The drip tray is sloped so that grease easily moves into a very small, removable drip pan that you toss in to the trash.
- Propane gas gauge to indicate when your tank is getting low before you run out
- 10,000 BTU burners produce plenty of even heat throughout the cooking area

Options



- **Charcoal grills** – free standing Kettles, Kettles with shelves, Kettles with work tables and 4 different sizes; 18.5”, 22.5”, 26.75” & 44.75”. Look for the Gold or Platinum models with the ash pan catcher, it makes ash cleanup so easy. From \$30 to \$329
- **Q Grills** – Weber’s newest model comes in 3 sizes; some come with or without a stand for tailgating or backyard grilling. Most Q grills run on propane gas, but there are also charcoal and electric models available.
- **Spirit Gas Grills** – Weber’s entry level gas grill. There are 5 models with either 2 or 3 burners and some with or without side burners. Most models come in black, but there are also 2 options with a stainless hood and front panels. From \$399 to \$619.
- **Genesis Gas Grills** – This line is Weber’s most popular grill and for good reason. It will easily last 20 years and provides excellent service along the way. All Genesis grills have 3 main burners with optional side burners & sear burners. It’s easy to add a rotisserie, griddle or pizza stone for cooking breakfast, lunch or dinner. They come in 5 finishes: black, green, copper, brick red, steel gray or stainless. The Genesis line burns either propane or natural gas. From \$699 to \$969.
- **Summit Gas Grills** – These grills compete with grills twice their price. There are two sizes; 4 burner or 6 burner grill. There are cart models, built-in models and entire grill centers that come complete with power burners, trash drawers, paper towel holders, storage shelves and ice bins. Other options include rotisseries, sear burners, side burners and wood chip burners for real wood smoke. Summit grills come with 2 finishes; black or stainless. They burn propane or natural gas. From \$1399 to \$3,999.

Customer Support

Purchasing a grill is similar to purchasing a car in that it will last a long time, but will require parts down the road. One of the most important decisions in selecting a grill is knowing whether the company will be around to honor their warranty and provide parts when needed.

Weber has weathered the test of time. They have a terrific 800 customer support line, have honored their warranties for 59 years and offer parts for any grill they manufacture. You can’t have a better company standing behind your purchase.
